Simulation:

Roland has submitted jobs. More than 2600 jobs are running. Liverpool and milano have been banned due to crash.

The problem of mapping for the software installation is understood but not yet solved. Most of the site are using the role lcgadmin which was attribute to the new certificate of Joel instead of the old one.

Reconstruction:

Problem of submission which was due to a problem of port on volhcb02.

The backlog at CERN has disappeared after the intervention of castor people. The new release version will be deployed the 18th of June and will last at least 6 hours.
